

ACCELERATED MASSAGE THERAPY PROGRAM: ANATOMY SELF-STUDY MODULES: DETAILS

Purpose:

The purpose of these modules is to ensure that applicants possess an in-depth understanding of all musculoskeletal structures necessary to proceed effectively through the Accelerated Massage Therapy Program.

Kinesiology programs include some of this content, but not the volume or depth that is required of a graduate of our Massage Therapy Program. Therefore, a partial anatomy exemption may be granted for admission into the Accelerated Program. Completion of these modules bridges the gap between anatomy content presented in a Kinesiology program and that which is expected of a Massage Therapy student.

All applicants of the Accelerated Massage Therapy Program are required to complete these modules.
